



Lacrosse Academy Information in a Nutshell

- Check-In** Registration at both Denison sessions is from **1 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.** Staff members and signs at the entrances to campus will direct you to registration areas.
- Directions** Directions to both camp sites are available on our website or through any online mapping service. At Denison, use the main entrance (President's Drive) or the rear entrance (Washington Dr.). At both entrances there will be signage and staff to direct you.
- Early or Late?** Please notify us by email (Ashlin@thelacrosseacademy.com) if your son will be arriving or departing early or late.
- Airport Rides** Please notify us by email (Ashlin@thelacrosseacademy.com) if your son needs a ride to or from the airport. There is a \$25 fee per trip that can be paid in advance
- Payment** Full payment is due 30 days before camp. At our website you can login to the account you created when you registered and check your balance. You can pay your balance in two ways. 1) Time saving – login to your account and pay your balance with an online payment. A convenience fee is added for any online payments. 2) Money saving- Save yourself the convenience fee by simply mailing a check for your balance to: **The Lacrosse Academy, 209 East Elm St., Granville, OH 43023.**
- Needed Forms** We must have completed and signed **Waiver of Liability** and **Medical Information Forms** for all campers. The medical form does not require a physician's signature but campers do need to have been cleared by a physician. Our Athletic Trainer will be on hand to review all forms and consult with parents as needed. If you do not fill out these forms and submit them when you register, you may print them and mail them to the address above.
- Room Deposit** A \$40 key deposit is required at the time of registration. This deposit can be paid in cash or by check, both of which will be returned at check out, when your son returns his key. If you use a check, it should be a separate check made out to The Lacrosse Academy for \$40.
- Day Campers** Day campers need to register and checkout at the same as overnight campers. On regular camp days, they should be dropped off at 8:30 a.m. at the dorms where you registered. They will be served lunch and dinner. In the evening, boys can be picked up between 8:45 and 9:00 pm at the same place. Some local parents come to watch the boys play in the evening (you'll have to sort of wander around to find them!)
- Roommates** We make every effort to honor roommate requests between 2 boys. See FAQs on website for more info.
- What to Bring** Please see details at our website. Helmet, stick, gloves, chin strap, shoulder pad, athletic protective "cup", broken-in cleats and sneakers, regular twin bedding, fans, lots of clean underwear, socks and tee shirts, toiletries, snacks if desired (there are no fridges). Goalies – chest and throat protectors. Please **DON'T BRING** – expensive items and electronics.
- Camp "Banks"** Campers may set up "banks" so they do not have to handle money and to reduce the possibility of losing money. Cash or a separate check may be deposited to this account during registration. Any balance is returned.
- Cars** Campers who drive to camp may not drive during camp and must turn in their keys at registration.
- Emergency #s** During camp you can reach the Directors via cell phones. Less urgent calls can go to Ashlin Caravana (740) 973-9348. Call Doug Bartlett (540) 817-0050 or Mike Caravana (740) 973-8883 if your call is urgent.
- Check-Out** Check-out is 11:30 a.m. on the last day of camp for both Denison sessions. All campers, even Day Campers should go through the check-out line so we can make sure keys, meal cards and bank balances are returned. Campers pack-up their belongings before heading out to their last session. Please let us know in advance if your camper must depart at a different time.
